II. Chairperson's Report

a. 2021-2022 Budget Update

The Board of Education (BOE) presented a 2.5% Board of Finance (BOF) directed budget to the BOF at the March 16, 2021 BOF meeting. The BOF will provide a directive to the BOE on April 6, 2021 for the Public Hearing presentation on April 20, 2021. The Town Meeting is scheduled for April 27, 2021. The BOF will send a list of budget questions to the BOE.

III. Superintendent's Report

a. Suffield Regional Agriscience Center Consulting Committee Nominees

The Suffield Regional Agriscience Center asked the BOE to appoint two new members to serve on The Suffield Regional Agriscience Center Consulting Committee for a three year

term. Suffield nominated Jonathan and Lisa Griffin. John Corcoran served on the committee for the last six years so the BOE nominated John Corcoran and Lisa Griffin.

MOTION: a motion was made by John Welsh, seconded by Bob Ravens-Seger to appoint Lisa Griffin and John Corcoran as East Granby representatives to serve on The Suffield Regional Agriscience Center Consulting Committee for a three year term. b. School Update/Student Enrollment

More distance learners are returning to in-person learning and more are expected starting the fourth quarter, April 5, 2021. The BOE projects the addition of a fourth section to grade 5 (17/18/18/18) for FY 21-22. Three sections would be class sizes of 24/24/23 (guidelines = 22). This is an additional teacher not factored in the FY 21-22 budget. Students will return to in-person learning on Wednesdays beginning on April 7, 2021 for elementary students and April 28, 2021 for middle/high school students. Wednesdays will remain early release days but modified to thirty minutes sooner than the usual early release times. Updated information on the free lunch/breakfast program, COVID19, quarantine guidance, and travel guidance were shared. The superintendent will send a correspondence to families detailing these important updates.

c. Graduation Date and Last Day of School

The district had three traditional snow days extending the school year for students from June 9, 2021 to June 14, 2021.
