



BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday May 14, 2025

Town Hall Meeting Room – 6:30 PM

1. **CALL TO ORDER** – A meeting of the East Granby Board of Selectmen (BOS) was held on Wednesday May 14, 2025 at the Town Hall Meeting Room. First Selectwoman Wimpfheimer called the meeting to order at 6:31pm. Selectman Hall was present.

Selectman Hall made a motion to change **4. Minutes** date 03/17/2025 to 03/26/2025 and add to **6(d) Suspense List**. Seconded by First Selectwoman Wimpfheimer.

2. **PUBLIC COMMENT** – A resident asked questions regarding MDC. Another resident spoke about an ordinance for backyard shooting.
3. **CORRESPONDENCE** – America 250; Eversource; Letter from Resident
4. **MINUTES** – Selectman Hall made a motion to accept the March 26, 2025 and the April 29, 2025 minutes as presented. Seconded by First Selectwoman Wimpfheimer. **Motion Approved Unanimously.**
5. **OLD BUSINESS**
 - a. **Back Office Shared Services Opportunities** – No new information.
 - b. **Sewer Update** – First Selectwoman Wimpfheimer stated a comprehensive study is currently taking place. During this period, we will collect consistent data and report findings back to MDC for reevaluation of our sewer billing.
 - c. **FY26 Budget Update** – Referendum will be held on May 20, 2025 at the Mary Ellen Brown Senior Community Center from 6:00am to 8:00pm. For an Annual Budget of \$5,865,600 for the General Government and \$20,923,500 for the Board of Education.

- d. Tax Collector Report & Refunds** – Selectman Hall made a motion to accept the Tax Collector’s Report as presented. Seconded by First Selectwoman Wimpfheimer. **Motion Approved Unanimously.**
