



BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday August 27, 2025

Town Hall Meeting Room – 6:30 PM

1. **CALL TO ORDER** – A meeting of the East Granby Board of Selectmen (BOS) was held on Wednesday August 27, 2025 at the Town Hall Meeting Room. First Selectwoman Wimpfheimer called the meeting to order at 6:30pm. Selectman Hall and Selectperson Thompson were present.
2. **PUBLIC COMMENT** – Resident asked the BOS to remove the land sale of 159 Hartford Avenue and to have First Selectwoman Wimpfheimer recuse herself from this matter.

 - e. **Sewer Update** – Since replacing Meter Pit 5 significant positive changes have been seen in the readings. The meter is now consistently reporting about 50 gallons of water per minute compared to the previous 200 to 250 gallons per minute.
