

**East Granby Board of Education
Curriculum Subcommittee Meeting Minutes for
October 22, 2025**

Welcome: Marjorie Light called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

Attendance: Present at the meeting were board members Amanda Cormier, Lisa Griffin, and Lynn Landolina. Marjorie Light, Director of Curriculum & PD was also present.

Old Business:

- State initiatives for curriculum and PD - Marjorie reviewed the state initiatives for curriculum, which requires the Boards of Education in the state to post their curriculum to district websites by July 1, 2026. This was discussed at a prior meeting, after the legislation was passed, so she provided updates on plans to complete this work. Steve Mosher is working with Marjorie to create new pages on our district website to accommodate this work.
- Scope and sequence documents that were discussed previously are being created K-12, with many of them being completed. These documents will serve as the basis for the BoE Curriculum website. Superintendent Palmieri is eager to review these documents to see how EGPS helps students learn and grow.

New Business:

- New state initiatives for the coming year: Play-Based Learning mandatory for PreK and Kindergarten. Our teachers have already received PD this summer and fall through CREC. During professional learning days, they are using online webinars to enhance their understanding of implementation.
- Upcoming professional development - The upcoming November 4th professional development day features collaborative learning opportunities across many districts. East Granby, Granby, Simsbury, Avon, and West Hartford all are offering blocks of time for educators who teach the same disciplines to gather and share goals, resources, innovative teaching strategies, and cross-curricular initiatives. Teachers will travel to regional workshops and follow agendas that focus on these areas, which were developed by the district administrators.
