### d. Consider and Act Upon the May 16, 2023 Referendum Questions -

QUESTION 1 - "Shall the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 in the amount of \$5,434,915 for the General Government; \$19,142,402 for the Board of Education; \$1,223,190 for Debt Service; \$700,000 for the Capital Reserve Fund totaling \$26,500,507 be adopted as recommended by the Board of Finance?" Yes/No

QUESTION 2 ADVISORY VOTE (non-binding) – In your opinion is the General Government Budget in the amount of \$5,434,915 an increase of 3.98% or \$208,165, the right amount, too low, or too high?

QUESTION 3 ADVISORY VOTE (non-binding) – In your opinion is the Board of Education Budget in the amount of \$19,142,402 an increase of 3.99% or \$735,402, the right amount, too low or too high?

Selectman Hall made a motion to approve the 2023 Referendum questions as presented. Seconded by Selectman Oliva. **Motion Approved Unanimously**.
