- 3. To consider and act upon the appropriation of a sum not to exceed \$6,000 from the Capital Non-Recurring Fund for iPad Protective Cases as recommended by the Boards of Education and Finance. Any unexpended funds are to be returned to the Capital Fund.
- 4. To consider and act upon the appropriation of a sum not to exceed \$50,000 from the Capital Non-Recurring Fund to repair/replace MS/HS doors as recommended by the Boards of Education and Finance. Any unexpended funds are to be returned to the Capital Fund.
- 5. To consider and act upon a resolution to accept a 2022 STEAP Grant in the amount of \$500,000 for East Granby Farms Phase II.
