Motion was made by Christine Gallagher and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the town close the Fire Department UTV, Fire Department Air Pack Replacement Bottles and the Senior/Community Center Kitchen Renovations and return existing funds to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Christine Gallagher and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the town close the School Technology, School Telephone System, Allgrove Parking Lot, MS/HS HVAC Expansion, Allgrove Fuel Tank and Allgrove Hot Water Heater Conversion and return existing funds to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Education and Finance. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Christine Gallagher and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that a sum not to exceed \$49,617 from the Capital Non-Recurring Fund to purchase and equip a new police vehicle with any unexpended funds to be returned to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Christine Gallagher and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that a sum not to exceed \$150,000 from the Capital Non-Recurring Fund for the refurbishment of Engine 3 with any unexpended funds to be returned to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Christine Gallagher and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that a sum not to exceed \$65,816 from the Capital Non-Recurring Fund to purchase a Senior Mini Bus with any unexpended funds to be returned to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Christine Gallagher and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that a sum not to exceed \$39,000 from the Capital Non-Recurring Fund to replace the camera server at RD Seymour School with any unexpended funds to be returned to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Education and Finance. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Christine Gallagher and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that a sum not to exceed \$59,600 from the Capital Non-Recurring Fund for School Technology with any unexpended funds to be returned to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Education and Finance. Motion carried.
