

# TOWN & SCHOOL BUILDING COMMITTEE MINUTES

## SPECIAL MEETING

November 2, 2022 – 6:30 pm

1. **CALL TO ORDER** -- A special meeting of the East Granby Town & School Building Committee was held in the small conference room at the East Granby Town Hall. Chairman Jim Hayden called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm. In attendance were Jim Hayden, Bob Ravens-Seeger, Rick Granger, and Mike Malloy.
