Intro to Backpacking

Love hiking? Want to venture beyond the car campground exploring the backcountry with a pack on your back? Ready to head out and explore the wilderness but don't have the comfort level to go it alone or don't know where to start? Let us help you learn the basics (and some secret advanced stuff too) and plan and execute your first backpacking experience. We'll cover everything from trip and meal planning, packing your pack, dealing with wild animals, storing your food, to even how to go to the bathroom in the woods (GASP!).

Our class will learn the basics in a classroom environment, take a practice hike to test out equipment, and finish with a three-day, two-night trip on the Appalachian Trail here in CT. We'll practice and follow Leave No Trace principles and philosophy in our planning and execution of our class. This class is ideally suited for people that have previous hiking experience and are physically active. Backpacking involves carrying your equipment in a specially designed pack over various terrain. Plan to hike 5 – 7 miles daily on our three-day trip carrying 30 – 50 lbs depending on your size and needs. Group size limited to 6 persons. Ages- 14 and up. Kids under 18 must be accompanied by a responsible registered adult.

Kindergarten Extension

This year we will also be offering a kindergarten extension program for our 4- & 5-year-old campers. This program is geared toward those students starting Kindergarten in Fall 2022.

The extension program will be a time for our older camps to strengthen their academic skills by learning letters and numbers up to 20 as well as working in small groups and learning/using problem solving strategies that are age appropriate.

East Granby Youth Service Bureau

The mission of the East Granby Youth Service Bureau is to coordinate the delivery of community-based services for prevention, intervention, treatment, and follow up for at risk youth, and to provide opportunities for all youth to function as responsible members of the community.

Commission on Youth Services

The commission on Youth Services (CYS) has been established to serve in an advisory capacity and support the mission and staff of the Youth Services Bureau. Members are appointed by the board of selectman and represent various segments of the community including law enforcement, education, children and families, and local business and organization. The goal of the CYS is to advocate for our youth population by evaluating priority needs and interests on an ongoing basis and assisting the YSB in the development of appropriate programs and services. Meeting are held every third Monday of the month and are open to the public.

Counseling Services

Counseling services addressing emotional, behavioral, and mental health issues are available for children and families residing in East Granby. We provide parenting support, family therapy, individual therapy, play therapy for children, and school consultation. School, parent, and self referrals are accepted. All services are professional and confidential and are offered free of charge to East Granby residents.

We can address a range of issues including:

- Common developmental issues
- School behavior and/or peer relationship issues
- · Family conflicts
- Suicide ideation
- Depression

Youth and Family Therapy Services Available

- Anger management
- Eating disorders
- Substance abuse
- Self-mutilation

For many children, this year's transition back to school may bring a greater magnitude of change than ever before. Whether students are transitioning from remote learning back to in-person instruction, or from small hybrid classes to full classrooms, these adjustments can create significant anxiety for kids of all ages. Should you find your children or family in need of some additional support during the school year, please remember that the Youth Service Bureau offers free counseling services to East Granby youth and their families. All counseling services are confidential and are provided by a licensed therapist or professionally supervised intern. School, parent and self-referrals are all welcome. Youth Action Council

The Middle School Youth Action council has been busy this winter with participating in and planning fun community activities. In the next upcoming months, we are planning to start some new programs, including a Middle School Girls Circle.

American Red Cross Babysitting Course

East Granby Youth Services Bureau presents the American Red Cross Babysitting Course. This course is an interactive course to teach young adults the basics of babysitting and how to manage the responsibilities of being a caregiver. This is a one-day class and participation for the entire day is required to get certification.



All participants should wear comfortable clothes and bring a water bottle and lunch. Snacks will be provided. Space is limited for this class and full payment is required in order to guarantee your space in the class.

Home Alone Safety for Kids

Home Alone Safety for Kids is a unique class for boys and girls ages 8 to 13 years old who are left home alone. This interactive 90 minute course will cover safety concerns parents have when their children are by themselves. Students will learn to be more aware of the potential dangers that they could face when they are alone. Each student will receive a workbook that covers house key safety, indoor and outdoor (including kitchen) safety, gun safety, fires, and gas leaks. We will also review first aid kit essentials and phone, door, and internet safety.

The class size is limited to fifteen students to allow for optimal opportunities for participation. Parents/guardians are asked to attend the last ten minutes of the course. They will receive a workbook with conversations starters such as creating a family fire escape plan and the importance of an emergency contact list.

A Juvenile Review Board (JRB) has been established to provide a community-based program for diverting eligible juvenile cases from the Juvenile Justice System, and to provide intervention at the local level. The JRB is comprised of 11 members appointed by the Board of Selectmen representing key areas of our community, including law enforcement, school officials, court personnel, and local community members. The goal of the JRB is to make effective recommendations to assist the juvenile in avoiding repeat behaviors leading to an arrest or a school-based referral to the Juvenile Justice System.
