

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION  
TOWN OF EAST GRANBY**

Notice is hereby given that at a Special Town Meeting of the Town of East Granby, Connecticut held on Tuesday, October 24, 2017 at 7:30 pm the following ordinances were adopted or amended:

An Ordinance entitled “Proposed Code Adoption Ordinance”. The following ordinances were amended:

**AN ACT AMENDING ARTICLE VII  
“EXEMPTION FOR  
VOLUNTEER FIRE AND AMBULANCE PERSONNEL”  
OF THE ORDINANCES OF  
THE TOWN OF EAST GRANBY**

WHEREAS, the East Granby Ambulance Association (EGAA) no longer exists but has been merged into the Granby Ambulance Association (GAA), Article VII §255-12 et seq of the Ordinances of the Town of East Granby is hereby amended as follows:

1. All references in Sections 255-12 through 255-21 to “East Granby Ambulance Association” (“EGAA”) are hereby deleted and replaced with “Granby Ambulance Association” (“GAA”).
2. In the future, should the Granby Ambulance Association merge with another volunteer ambulance association, all residents of the Town of East Granby who are volunteer members of the new ambulance association shall be eligible for benefits under this ordinance.
3. Section 255-15 A is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted therefore:  
“Maximum Benefit. The maximum benefit under this Section shall be One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars for all eligible GAA members and One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars for eligible EGFD members who have attained Firefighter One Certification and Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars for all eligible persons not having attained Firefighter One Certification”
4. This Amendment to Ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its adoption and publication.

These ordinances will become effective 15 days after publication.
