Motion was made by Bill Pitney and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the town close the Town Hall Windows, Backhoe, Plow Truck, Police Cruiser, Fire Department Utility Truck and Roof Design and return existing funds to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Betty Ann Hayden and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that a sum not to exceed \$8,000 from the Capital Fund to paint and repair the Historical Society and Kilbon Barns at East Granby Farms with any unexpended funds to be returned to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Rick Newhall and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that a sum not to exceed \$23,000 from the Capital Fund to replace 20 Fire Department Air Pack Replacement bottles and related accessory equipment with any unexpended funds to be returned to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Rich Galluccio and seconded to adopt the following RESOLUTION: BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that a sum not to exceed \$15,000 from the Capital Fund for the Senior Community Center Kitchen Renovations with any unexpended funds to be returned to the Capital Fund as recommended by the Boards of Selectmen and Finance. Motion carried.
