- <u>67 Nicholoson Rd</u> Received Site Plan for Max Transportation to construct new 24k sq ft building with 2 other tenant spaces to be heard at December PZC Meeting.
- <u>8 School St-</u>Received Special Exception for Signs Plus to add 2488 sq warehouse/manufacturing space to existing building with two apartments above. IWC and PZC to be heard at the January Meetings.

### **B. Projects Under Construction**

- <u>17 Kripes Rd</u> Almost Famous Brewery approved. Site work in progress. Still await their federal and state licenses. Working with MDC on fire suppression system.
- <u>62 Rainbow Rd</u> Cumberland Farms' application was approved by the Planning and Zoning Commission in April. DOT is doing appraisal of triangular
